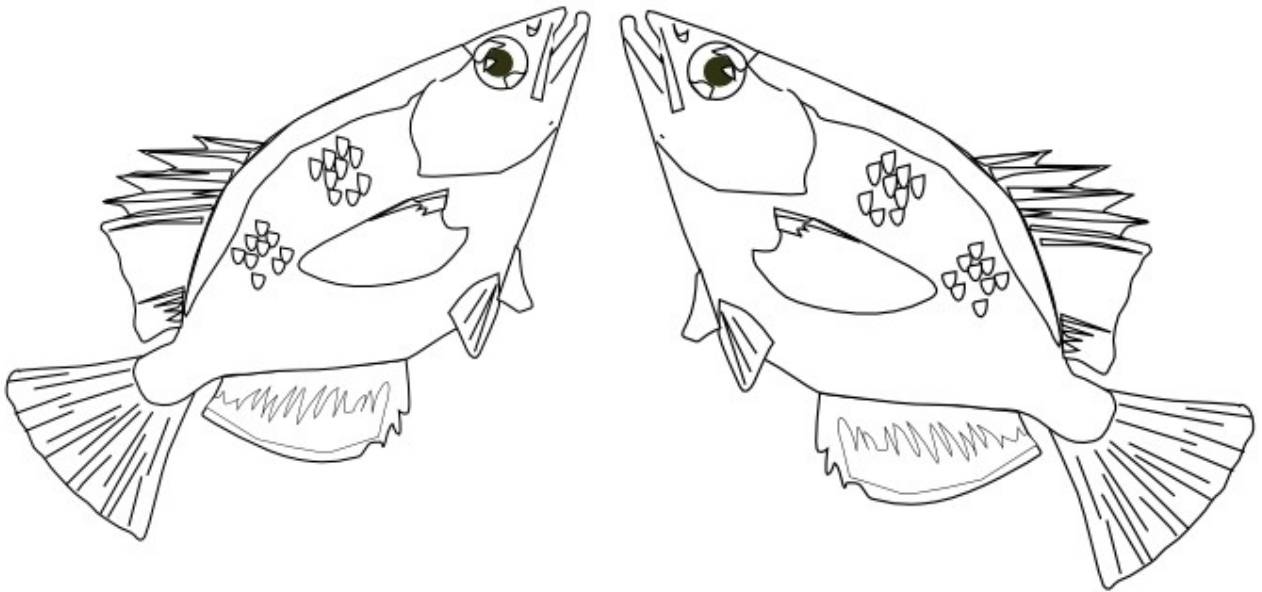
1 Oscar

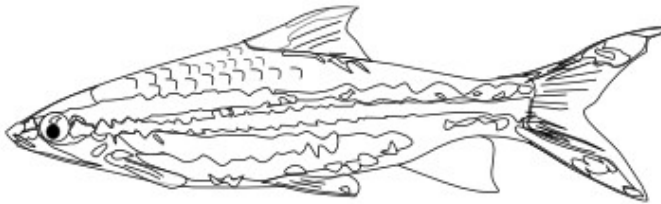
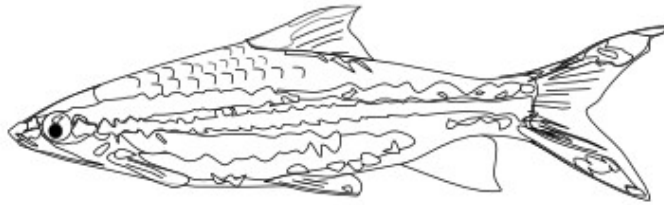
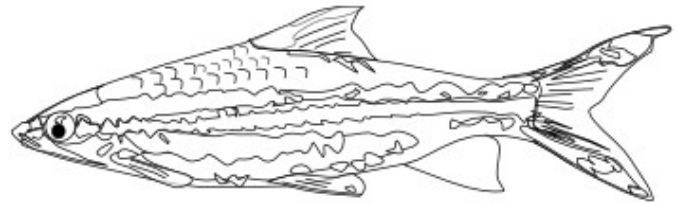
Archer fish

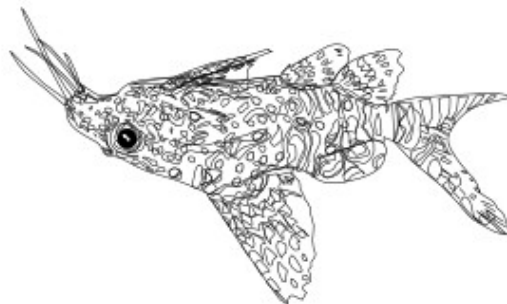
Denison Barbs

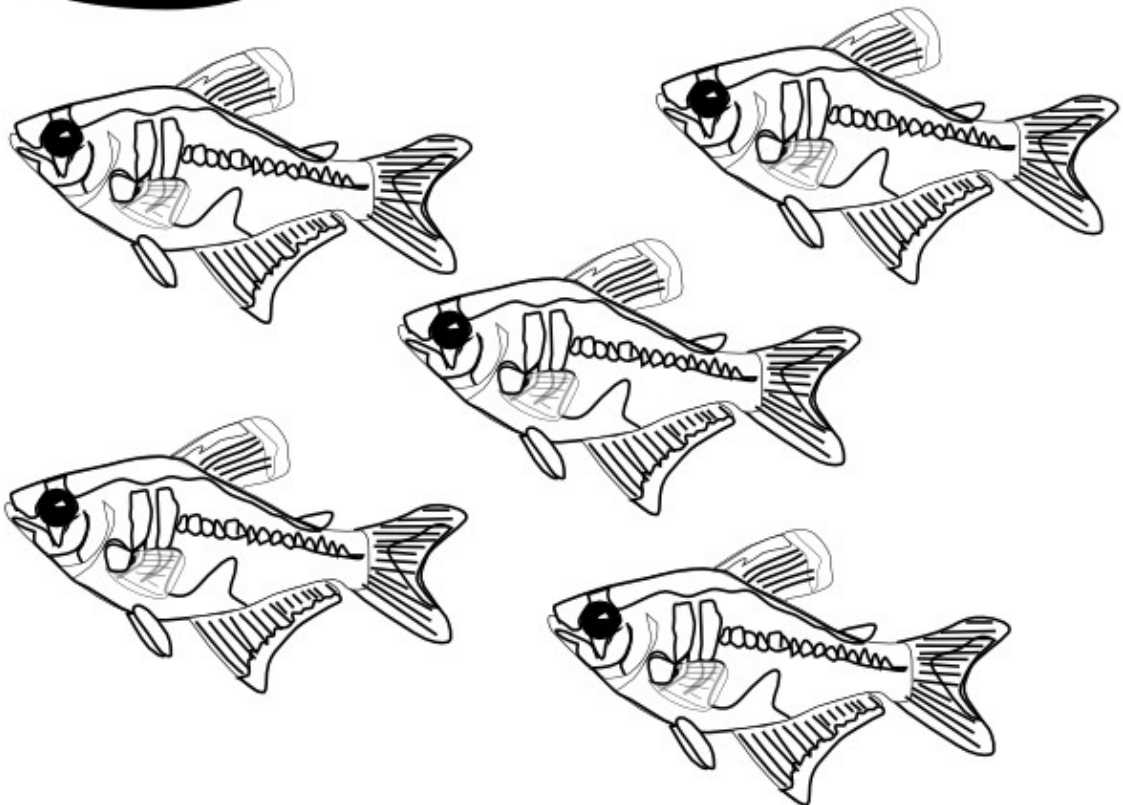
Upside-down Catfish

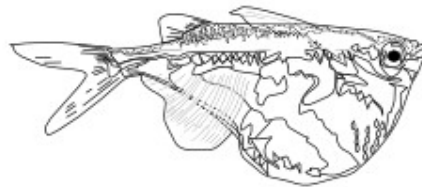
Serpae Tetras



Serpae tetras like to swim in groups. They come from South America

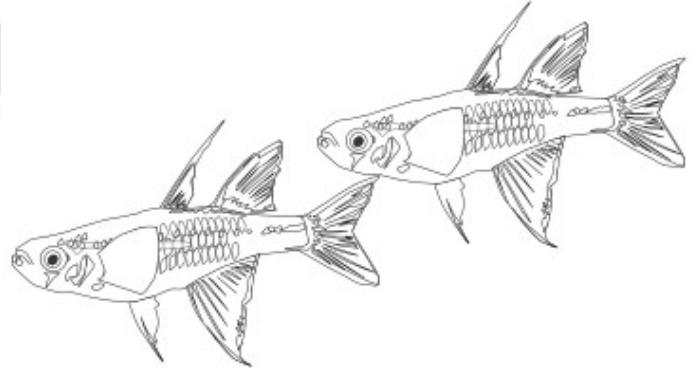

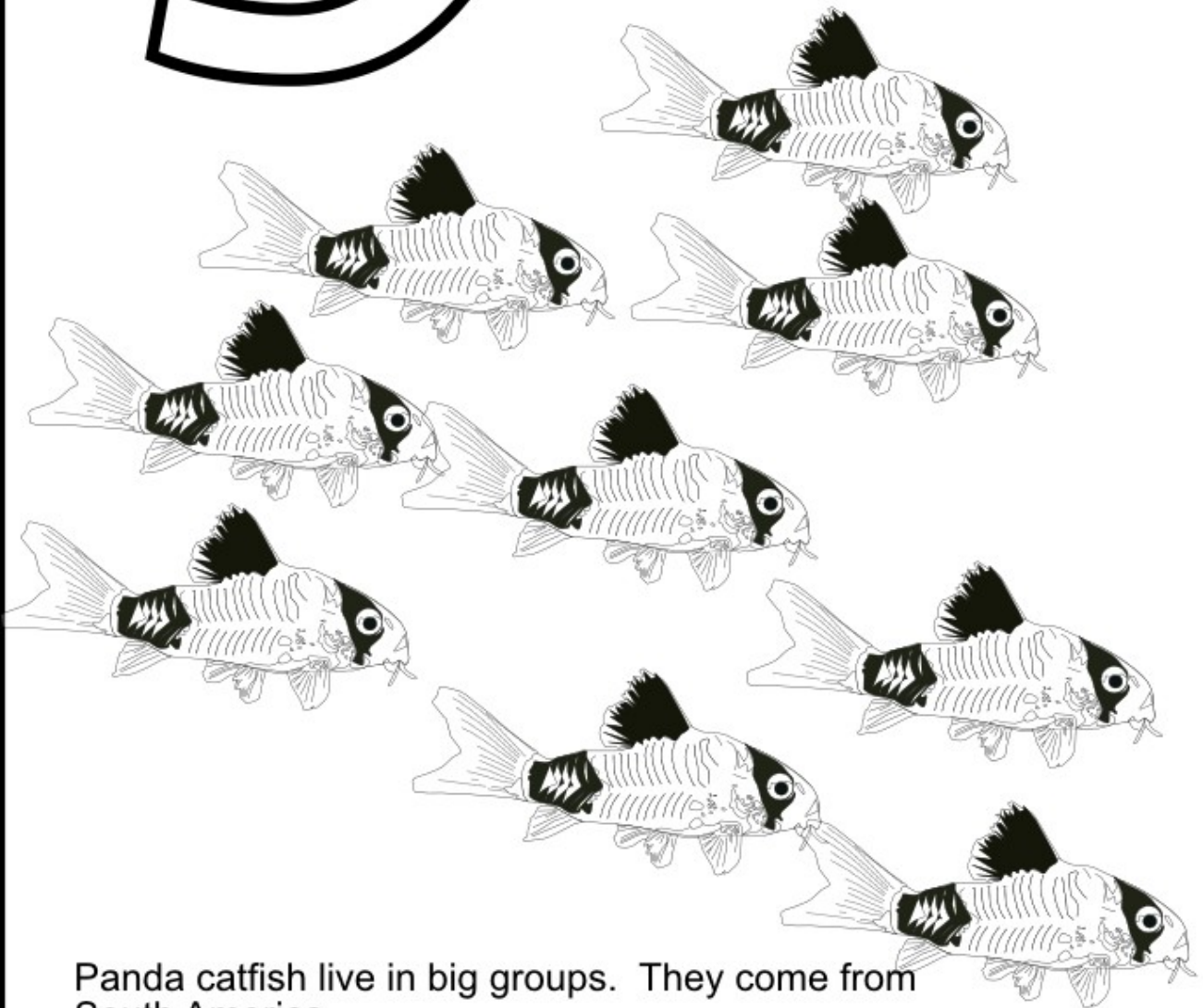
Zebra fish

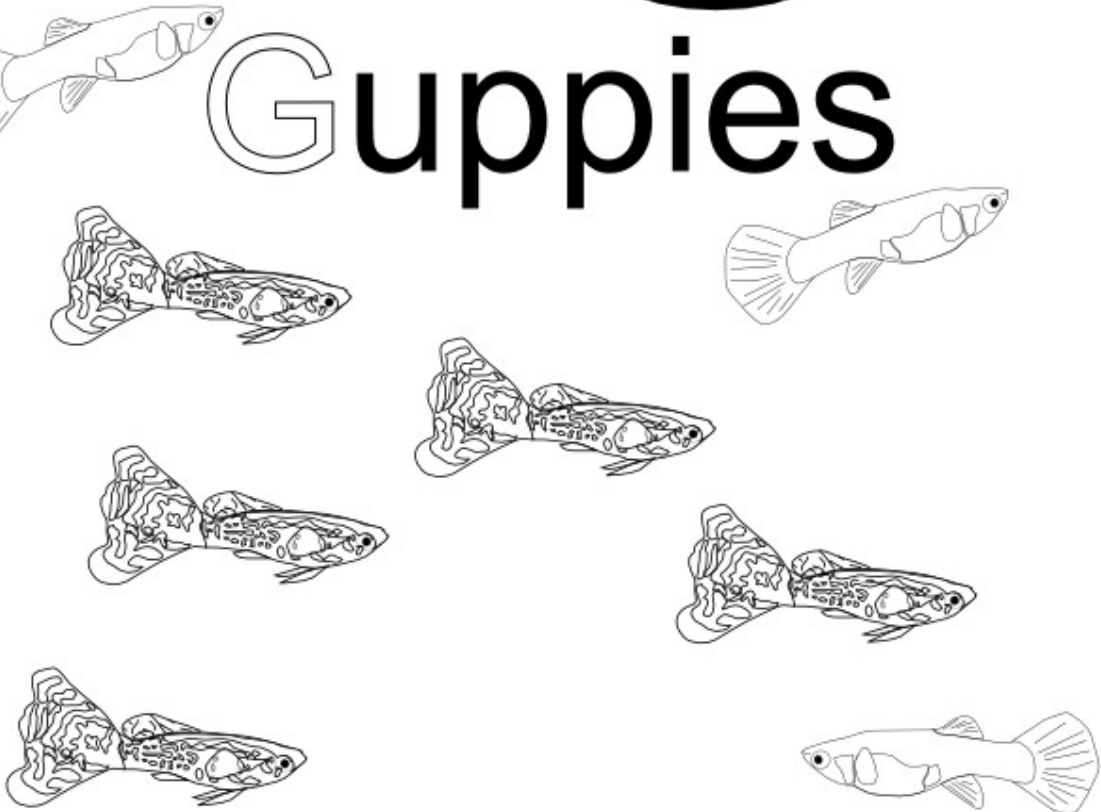
Panda catfish
